IGCSE Ceremony for our Class 2021 – Congratulations!

The Year 10 students wrote their exams in May, provisional results were issued in August, in November the students could finally receive their IGCSE Certificates. Nine students could achieve passing grades in all subjects, which are required for the recognition as the equivalent to the German graduation certificate “Erweiterter Sekundarabschluss I”.

We are proud of the variety of languages in which some of our students took exams: Besides German and English, we had entries in Spanish, Chinese and French. These subjects show the variety of nationalities in the students’ community.

Three students were registered for the ICE award, which recognises the achievements of learners in at least seven IGCSE subjects. One student got the Cambridge ICE award with distinction, the other two with merit.

Two of our students – Carl and Christoph – reached outstanding results in all subjects (A\*).

All of our students have done pretty well under extraordinary circumstances. Congratulations to all of you!
