Dear parents and guardians,
Dear students, dear staff members,

I want to share a letter sent out by the Minister of Education of Lower Saxony (attached to this email) and the latest decisions affecting our daily school life. Due to the regular testing of students and staff in all schools in Lower Saxony, a range of Corona cases have been discovered. I am happy to inform you that all self-tests of our students at the International School showed negative results, which is an indicator that our school is a safe place.

I would also like to inform you that the delivery of self-tests takes place regularly every week, and as mentioned in a previous email, we are improving our routines of packing and giving out the tests to the students.

Thank you for your permanent support and for conducting the tests at home!

You may be aware that the Ministries of Education and Health discuss easings in all parts of life.

For all kindergartens and schools in Lower Saxony, new regulations apply:

Preschool and Reception Class	Incidence in Braunschweig below 165	All children in school, No mixing of groups
	Incidence in Braunschweig higher than 165	Emergency supervision for half of the children
Year 1 to Year 4, Year 10, Year 12	Regardless of incidence in Braunschweig	Scenario B
Year 5 to Year 9, Year 11	Incidence in Braunschweig below 165	Scenario B
	Incidence in Braunschweig higher than 165	Scenario C

The City Authorities will communicate any changes in the scenarios in a general decree. They may also take stricter measures if necessary. We will communicate any changes with you promptly.
